PG&E – ENET Program Status Update– David Ore (PG&E)

David, program manager for the ENET program, will present a status report on the ENET program and the status of updated interconnection protocols (Rule-21).

Self Generation Program – CPUC – John Galloway (CPUC) John will provide details of how the Self-Generation Program is progressing, including reservation and installed system data for PG&E, SCE, San Diego, and So Cal Gas. He will also review the status of Interconnection Protocols for PV systems larger than 10 kW, which as of 11/18, is an area of contention with the utilities, CPUC, and the PV industry.

CEC Renewable Energy Program – Tim Tutt (California Energy Commission)

*Tim will discuss the status of the Renewable Energy Program (Rebates etc.), which is currently not approved to start in 2002. Also, the issue of **Taxable Rebates**, and the distribution plan for **\$8M for Municipal Electric Customers** for <10kW systems (as a result of SBX5).*

California Power Authority – PV RFB – Tracy Saville (California Power Authority)

Tracy will describe the current Request for Bid solicitation (and subsequent RFPs for specific projects) for Decentralized Solar, which seeks to install up to 80 MW of PV in the next 4 years in California

Architectural Resources at PEC – Bill Burke (Pacific Energy Center)

Bill will demonstrate the Heliodon, a building model evaluation tool, available for use at the Center. Very useful in evaluating shading concerns throughout the year.

San Francisco Solar Bond Measures B& H–

Several city and bond measure representatives will discuss the recent victory at the ballot box and what happens next.

SPIRE – Local Government Commission– Pat Stoner (LGC)

Pat will discuss the SPIRE program, a new initiative to implement renewable energy projects at the local government level.

PV and the State Building Codes (Title-24) Bruce Maeda (California Energy Commission)

Bruce will outline efforts to incorporate Photovoltaics into the next iteration of the Title-24 State Building Energy Codes.
