Our records show that you currently have on file with PG&E an application for interconnection with PG&E's electric distribution system of a generating facility under PG&E's Rate Schedule E-NET-Net Metering (E-NET). The purpose of this letter is to inform you that effective January 1, 2003, a change in California law (Assembly Bill, or AB 58) provides that new E-NET customers are required to pay Public Purpose Program (PPP) charges on their departed load. Certain customers, however, may qualify for an exemption.

PPPs are, funded by utility customers (with costs ranging from \$0.00247 to \$0.00487 per kwh depending upon the customer's rate schedule) to support energy research, energy efficiency, and renewable efforts in California. The California Public Utilities Commission (CPUC) is currently reviewing how the new law should be implemented.

AB58 provides that E-NET customers who meet both of the following conditions are exempt from such PPP charges :

- obtained all permits needed to **commence construction** of their E-NET generating facilities prior to **January 1, 2003; and**
- **completed construction** of their E-NET generating facilities on or before **September 30, 2003.**

To document eligibility for the exemption, PG&E is asking customers who potentially qualify to provide: 1) copies of the permit(s) authorizing the customers to commence construction of their generating facilities dated prior to January 1, 2003, and 2) copies of

the final building permit(s) for the generating facilities signed on or before September 30, 2003 by the local government entity with jurisdiction.

Since you have submitted an E-NET interconnection application, we wanted to be sure you were aware of this possible exemption and the construction completion deadline coming up on September 30th, 2003.
